About the survey: The Post Poll survey was conducted between February 21 and 28, 2022 among 4668 electors at 180 polling stations spread across 45 assembly constituencies of Punjab. The sampling design adopted was multi-stage systematic random sampling. The Assembly Constituencies were randomly selected using the probability proportional to size method. Thereafter, four polling stations within each of the sampled constituencies were selected using the systematic random sampling method. Within each polling station, 40 electors were randomly sampled from the electoral roll using the systematic random sampling method. Of these 40, 26 interviews were targeted. The interviews of electors were conducted face-to-face at their homes after voting had taken place in their area. The findings shown here have been weighted by gender, religion, locality, and caste group based on Census 2011 data and by the actual vote shares secured by the main parties/alliances — Congress, SAD-BSP alliance, AAP, and the BJP-PLC-SAD (Sanyukt) alliance - in the election.
